Continuing Education Seminar Information

he AACE Education Board is planning to offer four two-day continuing education seminars in conjunction with the International Total Cost Management Conference in Dubai this November. On the schedule for the two days prior to the opening of the International TCM Conference are:

Seminar 1: Certified Cost Professional (CCP) Certification Review Course

Instructor: Sean T. Regan, CCP CEP

1.6 CEUs This course will enable attendees to be better prepared to take the CCP Certification Examination beyond what they would likely achieve on their own. Professionals who attend this Certification Review Course are expected to be fairly well prepared to sit for the examination before arrival. This course is not intended to prepare a professional who routinely works in only one sub-element of cost engineering to pass the challenging Certification Examination, if they have done little study before the seminar. Attendees should have read and worked some problems in Skills and Knowledge of Cost Engineering, 5th Ed and CCP Certification Study Guide, 3rd Ed, to become relatively comfortable with the contents of these books. They should also reacquaint themselves with college algebra, such as logarithms and exponents. Ideally, attendees would have completed, at some time in the past, a baccalaureate course in business or engineering statistics, as well as engineering economy or finance. Students should bring a calculator with exponent and logarithm functions that meets certification examination specifications. A financial calculator is useful but not required. Learning Objectives: Probably the greatest benefit will derive from the learning objectives that require demonstration of numerical problem-solving skills. Obviously, what most benefits participants will vary with their backgrounds. Knowledge Areas: This course will primarily address those areas where numerical problem solving is of important consideration in a typical examination. The expectation is that professionals who do not routinely solve such problems will find that review to be more worthwhile. These primary areas will include engineering economics, estimating, scheduling and related subjects.

Seminar 2: Practical Use of 199 FIDIC Conditions of Contract, Module 1

Instructor: James C. Perry

1.6 CEUs What is the practical use of the FIDIC Contracts FIDIC contract documents? What is FIDIC and where do the FIDIC contracts come from? Why are FIDIC contracts structured the way they are? Which FIDIC contract should you use for your project? How do you set up a FIDIC contract?

Responsibilities of the main parties understanding the role and responsibilities of each of the main parties to a FIDIC contract is one of the keys to the success of the project and misunderstandings of the responsibilities are often the source of disagreements and disputes. General provisions, the employer, the contractor, the engineer, nominated subcontractors (Red Book), design (Yellow Book), as well as the management of projects, setting out the fundamental terms agreed between the parties to the contract, FIDIC contracts contain detailed obligations and procedures that are intended to help the parties to efficiently manage their project will be reviewed. What to do when your project "goes wrong" and many other issues will be answered in this seminar.

Seminar 3: Project Controls from the Owner's Perspective


